SHOW RULES

Entries received after the pre-entry deadline will incur a \$25 post-entry fee. Entries will be accepted on the day of show. However, a \$25.00 day of show penalty will apply.

Fees:

- Classes \$30
- Gold Crest Tack Derby \$40
- Gold Crest Shows Derby \$45
- Jackpot Mini Prix \$40
- Post Entry Fee \$25
- Day of Show Penalty \$25
- EMT Fee \$15 per rider
- Office Fee \$30 per entry
- Grounds Fee \$30 (For all non-stalled horses)
- Stall Fee \$50 per DAY (4 bag minimum per stall- or \$25 to bring your own bedding)
(\$95 for two days, \$135 for the weekend Friday-Sunday)

- All checks should be made payable to: GOLD CREST.

- Returned or unpaid checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days. A \$50.00 NSF fee will be charged.

- Non-showing horses must pay an office fee, EMT fee and a grounds fee.

REGULATIONS

1. Back to back rounds allowed and encouraged.
2. No-judges will be allowed as long as time permits.
3. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on show grounds.
4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 - 7:50 am. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class[es] should it be in the best interest of the show.
6. Only one horse per entry form.
7. A one minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.
8. Each class will award a first place trophy and ribbons through sixth place.
9. Champion and Reserve will be offered for all divisions.
10. Pets must be on a leash at all times.

BIOSECURITY AT THE COLORADO HORSE PARK REQUIRED:

1. A current negative Coggins test
 2. Vaccination records showing date of vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 (booster must be within 180 days)
 3. Health certificate dated by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of arriving at the venue** WNV, EEE, WEE, Tetanus and Rabies are strongly recommended.
- Horses may not unload until paperwork is approved. All horses must enter the facility off Bayou Gulch Road. There will only be one entrance open and it will be the first entry east of Ponderosa School and across from the church.
No entrance for horse show trailers through the top gate on South Pinery Dr.

Fences 2'3"-2'6". High options 2'9".

This performance hunter class presents competitors an opportunity to best showcase the talents of horse and rider over a challenging course with performance and handy options. The class combines a Hunter Classic with a Handy Hunter class in a one round format.

Judging: Each competitor receives a score with 3 components:

1. Hunter score (out of 100) - The class is judged as a handy hunter class with a score
2. Performance bonus - One bonus point awarded for each high performance option taken on course.
3. Handy bonus (up to 10 bonus points) – Zero to ten additional bonus points awarded at the judge's discretion for additional handiness and high performance displayed on course, including: Unique turns and approaches, inside turns, athleticism and boldness impressionable start and finish.

Formal attire required.

First place receives a \$50 gift certificate to Gold Crest Tack
Second place receives a \$20 gift certificate to Gold Crest Tack
Third place receives a \$10 gift certificate to Gold Crest Tack
Fourth through sixth place each receive a \$5 gift certificate

GOLD CREST SHOWS HUNTER DERBY

Class 201. Entry Fee \$45

Fences 3'. High options 3'3"-3'5".

This performance hunter class presents competitors an opportunity to best showcase the talents of horse and rider over a challenging course with performance and handy options. The class combines a Hunter Classic with a Handy Hunter class in a one round format.

Judging: Each competitor receives a score with 3 components:

1. Hunter score (out of 100) - The class is judged as a handy hunter class with a score
2. Performance bonus - One bonus point awarded for each high performance option taken on course.
3. Handy bonus (up to 10 bonus points) – Zero to ten additional bonus points awarded at the judge's discretion for additional handiness and high performance displayed on course, including: Unique turns and approaches, inside turns, athleticism and boldness impressionable start and finish.

Formal attire required.

First place takes all! One complete entry to a Gold Crest Horse Show! (Entry includes a stall, but not the shavings.)

JACKPOT VARIABLE MINI PRIX

Class 203. Entry Fee \$40

The Mini Prix will be ridden in variable heights. Each rider/horse combination must compete in at least 2 qualifying classes at the fence height they wish to ride the Mini Prix. The fence height may be any jumper division starting from a minimum of .85M (2'9").

For each horse entered, \$10 will be added back into the Jackpot. Prize money will be divided from the Jackpot to the top 8: 30%, 20%, 15%, 10%, 10%, 5%, 5%, 5%.

COVID 19 PROTOCOL- ALL IN ATTENDANCE MUST READ:

At Gold Crest we are trusting you to follow the below procedures in order to keep yourself and others at a minimized risk.

-Please attempt to make all entries electronically through horseshowing.com or email to coshowentries@gmail.com.

-Please take your temperature in the morning and scratch your entry if you have a fever. Do not come if you have COVID-19 symptoms or if you have been exposed to a confirmed case of COVID-19.

-Everyone should be mindful of space and keep a minimum of 6 feet away from any other person.

- Rotations will be set up with the gate person on a first come first served basis. If you miss your rotation, or do not sign up for one, you will ride at the end of the division.

-The gate person has complete authority of the arena entrance and will manage the entrance to limit numbers.

-Due to COVID-19, show hospitality will be greatly limited this year. Complimentary water bottles will be available at certain locations, but you should plan to bring your own as paper cups and water dispensers will not be available at the back gate.
