ALL TRAILERS MUST USE HUMBOLDT STREET ENTRANCE.

From I-25, take I-70 east to Brighton Blvd, Exit 275B. Stay right and merge onto Brighton Blvd. Take the 1st right onto 44th street. This becomes 46th street. Turn left onto Humboldt St.

BIOSECURITY: All trailers must use Humboldt Street entrance. All horses must be checked in through the show Biosecurity Staff. They must have a quick exam looking for signs of any infectious symptoms before being admitted onto the grounds and getting their stall assignment.

(If you prefer to present a Health Certificate dated within 24 hours of arrival, you may pass through the biosecurity checkpoint after document inspection and not pay the biosecurity fee. Otherwise, no Health Certificate is necessary.)

Additionally, all horses must have a health declaration filled out and signed to receive a number from the show secretary. Please see the Health Declaration below! Exhibitor safety is our first concern! THANK YOU!

SHOW RULES

Entries will be accepted on the day of show. However, a \$25.00 day of show penalty will apply.

Fees:

- Classes \$ 25
 - After Closing Penalty \$ 25
 - EMT Fee \$ 15 per rider
 - Biosecurity Personnel Fee \$ 20 per entry
 - Office Fee \$ 25 per entry
 - Stalls \$ 50 first day
 - \$ 25 each additional day
 - Grounds Fee \$ 15
1. No refunds will be given unless accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate.
 2. Stalls will be available for a fee of \$50.00 for the first day, and \$25 each additional day used. The stalls will not be bedded. Please call to reserve. Jenny 303-875-6184.
 3. Returned or unpaid checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days. A \$50.00 NSF fee will be charged.
 4. Non-showing horses must pay for office, EMT, Biosecurity Personnel and a stall/or grounds fee.

REGULATIONS

1. Back to back rounds allowed and encouraged.
2. No-judges will be allowed.
3. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on show grounds.
4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 - 7:45 am. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class(es) should it be in the best interest of the show.
6. Only one horse per entry form.
7. A one minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.
8. Each class will award a first place trophy and ribbons through sixth place.
9. Champion and Reserve will be offered for all divisions.
10. NO DOGS ALLOWED!
