SHOW RULES

- 1. All checks should be made payable to: GOLD CREST.
- 2. Entries can be paid with cash, check or venmo.
- 3. No refunds will be given unless accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate.
- 4. Stalls and shavings will be available. All stalls are required to have a five bag minimum per CHP regulations. You may bring in your own bedding, however a \$30 clean-out fee will be charged for bringing your own or purchasing less than the 5 bag minimum per stall. Text (or call) Jenny for stall and bedding orders at 303.875.6184.
- 5. Returned or unpaid checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days. A \$50.00 NSF fee will be charged.
- 6. Non-showing horses must pay an Administrative fee and a grounds fee.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Back to back rounds allowed and encouraged.
- 2. No-judges will be allowed as long as time permits.
- 3. Hard hats and boots with a heel must be worn at all times by all riders while on show grounds.
- 4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 7:40 am. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
- 5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class[es] should it be in the best interest of the show.
- 6. Only one horse per entry form.
- 7. A one minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.
- 8. Each class will award a first place trophy and ribbons through sixth place.
- 9. Champion and Reserve will be offered for all divisions.
- 10. Pets must be on a leash at all times!

In response to the 2022 EHV-1 and the 2023 Vesicular Stomatitis outbreaks in California and similar cases reported in other states, the Colorado Horse Park (CHP) and LEG Shows & Events are continuing to follow our enhanced biosecurity protocols to do our part to keep your horses safe, as well as those of your fellow competitors. To make your horses entrance to CHP as quick and easy as possible please submit all health certificates for pre-check to: horsehealth@langershows.com

Upon Arrival:

- We require all barns to check the temperature of all horses once they arrive at CHP, prior to entering the barn. If a horse has a temperature of 101.5 or higher, CHP management <u>must be contacted immediately</u>, and the horse placed in an isolation stall on-site to allow for time to recheck temperature prior to entering the show barn.
- CHP requires all barns on CHP show grounds to maintain a temperature log for each horse with twice-daily temperatures recorded. Random checks of temperature logs by the Barn Manager and Stewarding staff will take place.
- Any horse on the show grounds with a fever must be reported to CHP Management immediately. It is always better to err on the side of safety. Isolation stalls will be available on the grounds and at a local veterinary practice if the need arises.

It is our shared responsibility to keep our horses safe. Similar to the suggested protocols in place for humans due to COVID-19, we urge all equestrians to please remember and abide by additional biosecurity measures.

Additional Recommendations:

- Avoid mixing of horses where possible, practice equine 'social distancing'
- Please take the time to review equine good hygiene practices and impress its importance to your grooms and barn managers in everyday care.
- Bring your own hoses to barns and do not share water buckets or fill from hoses used by other horses. Communal hoses will NOT be provided in the barns. Please bring your own.
- Every effort should be made to minimize stress and commingling of horses shipped long distances. Extra hours on a horse van or moving from stable to stable is the fastest way to compromise your horses' and your neighbor's horses' health.
- CHP will practice additional biosecurity and disinfection protocols during our stall turnovers and around the facility on a daily basis.

We strongly recommend all horses stabling on the Colorado Horse Park Grounds arrive between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. If it is necessary to arrive at any other time **you must make arrangements prior to arrival**.

LEG Shows and Events Management strives to provide an excellent showing environment. An integral part of an excellent showing environment includes healthy horses. Exhibitors, especially those traveling long distances, can contribute to that healthy environment by adhering to the following requirements for entry to facility:

- 1. A current negative Coggins test is required for all horses entering the facility. Please renew before it expires, and not just before it is necessary to leave the state.
- 2. Statement of Health/Veterinary Health Certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of arrival at CHP, documenting that all horses have:
 - A. Received regular and consistent vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 with the most recent booster being within 180 days. IN NO CASES MAY THE BOOSTER BE OUTSIDE OF 180 DAYS. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be denied entry to the competition grounds upon request by Management.
 - B. Not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days.
 - C. Not been at a facility under quarantine for EHV-4/1 or exposed to any horses showing symptoms of EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days.
- 3. Current vaccination against WNV, EEE, WEE, Tetanus, Rabies are strongly recommended.
- 4. You should be able to document your horse's normal temperature before arrival. Please do not ship horses with elevated temperatures. It is recommended that you establish a log of temperatures taken at least twice daily.
 - Any horse on the show grounds with a fever over 101.5 must be reported immediately to LEG Horse Shows and Events Management and the Official Veterinarian. It is always better to err on the side of safety. Isolation stalls are available on the grounds and/or at a local veterinary practice if the need arises.
- 5. Every effort should be made to minimize stress and commingling of horses shipped long distances. Extra horses on a horse van, or moving from stable to stable is the fastest way to compromise your horse's and your neighbor's horse's health
- **6.** Please take the time to review equine good hygiene practices and impress its importance to your groom in everyday care.
- 7. All paperwork must be in the horse's show name.

SHOW ARRIVAL

All horses must enter from the west Bayou Gulch Road entrance ONLY (Gate 1 - Closest to Ponderosa High School). All horses must be checked for proper paperwork upon arrival and prior to being allowed entrance to the property. Any horses not having proper paperwork will not be allowed on the Colorado Horse Park property. OPEN 2'3"-2'6" JACKPOT HUNTER CLASSIC

Class 201. Entry Fee \$45

This Open Hunter Classic is a two round class that will be ridden at 2'3"-2'6" and open to any horse that is eligible to do the 2'3"-2'6" Open Hunters or the Modified Hunters. The horse and rider combination must declare intention to do the Classic before their Second Hunter over fences round in the 2'3"-2'6" Open Hunters or the Modified Hunters, as the division Second Hunter trip is also judged as the first round of the Classic. Afterwards, the combination will have a Handy Hunter round as the second round of the Classic. The Classic Round emphasizes quality, movement, and way of going, while the Handy Round rewards pace, brilliance, and clever options. May include tight turns, clever jump approaches, and trot jumps. Open Numerical scoring will be used to combine the scores of the two rounds and declare the winner.

For each horse entered, \$10 will be added back into the Jackpot. Prize money will be divided from the Jackpot to the top 8: 30%, 20%, 15%, 10%, 10%, 5%, 5%, 5%. Irish Knit Awards cooler presented to winner!

JACKPOT VARIABLE MINI PRIX

Class 202. Entry Fee \$45

The Mini Prix will be ridden in variable heights. Each rider/horse combination must compete in at least 2 qualifying classes at the fence height they wish to ride the Mini Prix. The fence height may be any jumper division starting from a minimum of .85M (2'9").

Formal attire encouraged.

For each horse entered, \$10 will be added back into the Jackpot. Prize money will be divided from the Jackpot to the top 8: 30%, 20%, 15%, 10%, 10%, 5%, 5%, 5%. Irish Knit Awards cooler presented to winner!
