Entries received after the pre-entry deadline will incur a \$25 post-entry fee. Entries will be accepted on the day of show. However, a \$25.00 day of show penalty will apply.

Fees:

• Classes	35
• Post Entry Fee	25
• Day of Show Penalty	25
• Entry Fee (includes all EMT and administrative fees)	55
• Stalls	75/day or 175/ Friday-Sunday
• Grounds Fee	35
• Shavings	15/bag
• Schooling Ticket	35/horse

SHOW RULES

1. All checks should be made payable to: GOLD CREST.
2. Entries can be paid with check, cash or venmo.
3. No refunds will be given unless accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate.
4. Stalls will be available for a fee of \$75/DAY (not overnight) or \$175 for the weekend. Call or text Jenny for stall and bedding orders at 303.875.6184.
5. Returned or unpaid checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days. A \$50.00 NSF fee will be charged.
6. Non-showing horses must pay an entry fee and a grounds fee.

REGULATIONS

1. Back to back rounds allowed and encouraged.
2. No-judges will be allowed as long as time permits.
3. Hard hats and boots with a heel must be worn at all times by all riders while on show grounds.
4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 - 7:30 am. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class[es] should it be in the best interest of the show.
6. Only one horse per entry form.
7. A one minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.
8. Each class will award a first place trophy and ribbons through sixth place.
9. Champion and Reserve will be offered for all divisions.
10. Pets must be on a leash at all times!

Turn left on Airport Road and follow it past the large white farm house for approximately 1/4 mile. You have reached Denver Polo Club when you see the large iron gates on the left. Go straight past those large iron gates and take the next left into the property. Follow the drive around to the barn area.

\$250 Gold Crest Fine Tack Gambler's Choice

Class 301 - Entry Fee: \$40

Open to all horses and ponies who have competed in at least one other non-prize money class at this show. In this competition, each obstacle carries a value from 10 points to 120 points depending upon difficulty. Obstacles will be built so that they may be jumped in both directions. After the starting tone, the competitor must cross the start line in either direction to start their time. They must then jump the obstacles, in either direction, a maximum of three times each, with the goal being to accumulate the highest point total. Disobediences are not penalized except for time taken. If an obstacle is knocked down, no points will be awarded. If an obstacle is jumped after being knocked down, no points will be awarded. If an obstacle is jumped a fourth time, no points will be awarded. When the 60 seconds has expired, a tone will sound and the competitor must cross the finish line to stop their time. At the conclusion of the round, and after their score has been announced, a tone will sound again and the competitor will have 30 seconds to attempt the Joker Jump. If jumped successfully, an additional 200 points will be added to their score. If a disobedience or knockdown occurs on the first attempt, 200 points will be deducted from their score. Only one attempt is allowed. The winner will be the competitor who has the highest point total in the fastest time. Fences 2'3" to 3'6" (Joker jump may be higher). Open to all horses and ponies. Entries must have competed in at least one other class at this show. Prize money divided to the top 6: \$75, \$60, \$40, \$30, \$25, \$20. Ribbons through 6th place. If fewer than 8 horses enter, management reserves the right to lower the entry fee and payouts accordingly.
