SHOW RULES

Please enter by Thursday, January 18th, 2023. Call or text 303.875.6184 to check availability for the show!

- Classes \$25
- EMT Fee \$20 per rider
- Office Fee \$30 per entry
- Grounds Fee \$20
- Stalls or Pens \$50 per day
- Shavings \$16/bag

- All checks should be made payable to: GOLD CREST.
- Returned or unpaid checks must be paid in cash or certified funds within 10 days. A \$50.00 NSF fee will be charged.
- Non-showing horses must pay an office fee, EMT fee and a grounds fee.

REGULATIONS

1. Back to back rounds allowed and encouraged.
2. No-judges will be allowed as long as time permits.
3. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on show grounds.
4. Controlled schooling will be allowed for 10 minutes between each fence division. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class[es] should it be in the best interest of the show.
6. Only one horse per entry form.
7. Each class will award a first place trophy and ribbons through sixth place.
8. Champion and Reserve will be offered for each fence height
9. Pets must be on a leash at all times.

Please wear formal horse show attire for hunter, equitation and Medal classes. After each division, the judge will meet with the exhibitors to discuss placings and judge's perspective! Presentation is a big piece of competing!

From the North:

Take i-25 south to Founders Parkway. Head east on Founders to 86. Take 86 east for 19.4 miles to the Messer Event Center on your left (north). There is a large boom truck parked by the sign at the driveway. Once on the dirt road, drive PAST the big indoor to enter the facility parking lot on the driveway behind the arena. Please park trailers backed in to spots perpendicular to the west side of the arena (This will seem evident when you are there!).



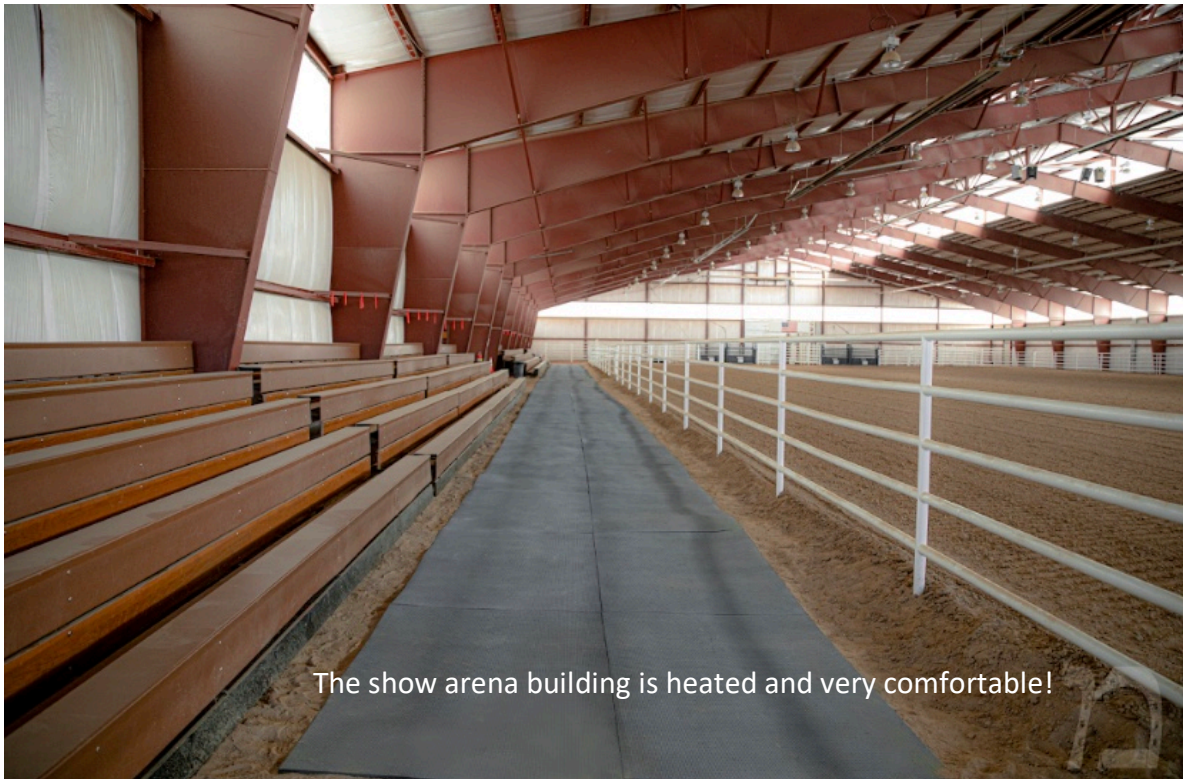
From the South:

Take 24 east to Elbert Road. Take Elbert Road north 26.5 miles. Turn left onto 86 and the Messer Event Center will be 1.3 miles on the north side of the road. There is a large boom truck parked by the sign at the driveway. Once on the dirt lane, drive PAST the big indoor to enter the facility parking lot on the driveway behind the arena. Please park trailers perpendicular to the side of the arena.

Please wear formal horse show attire. After each division, the judge will meet with the exhibitors to discuss placings and judge's perspective! Presentation is a big piece of competing in the Hunters and Equitation!
